

Project: Build and install wildlife nesting boxes in Little Bennett

Summary

This project entails mainly the installation of nestboxes already available at the Parks Dept as well as the possible construction of some new ones for Little Bennett Park. After conducting an inventory of Parks Dept birdbox availability, the leader of this project would work w/Park management to develop and implement a plan to deploy them in suitable locations in Little Bennett Park. The construction of additional nestboxes may also be part of this project if the Parks Dept agrees that they are needed.

Background

The incorporation of nesting structures for wood ducks, bluebirds, kestrels, bats and barn owls could improve conditions for several bird species in Little Bennett Park. The Montgomery County Parks Dept has an inventory several nestboxes available that could be installed in various sites in Little Bennett. Other types or additional nestboxes may also be needed.
