

Project: Litter and trash dump removal in Little Bennett Park

Summary

This project would remove litter along Little Bennett Park roads and/or a few small old trash dumps that remain in the Park. Park Police would control traffic on Park roads during cleanup activities and Park employees would haul away collected trash.

Background

Little Bennett Park is bordered by a four mile stretch of MD 355 and Clarksburg Road passes through the Park. Drivers on these two major roads often carelessly discard litter onto Park property as they pass by or through it. This litter despoils the natural beauty and scenery of the Park. Also, a few small old trash dumps remain in the Park from an earlier period when the parkland was privately owned and Montgomery County lacked a central waste collection facility.
